

The Board and Management of R. T. Briscoe (Nigeria) PLC ("the Company") hereby inform Nigerian Exchange Limited (NGX or the Exchange), the Company's shareholders and the general public of the resolution of the Board of Directors of the Company to extend the tenure of the current Group Managing Director/Chief Executive Officer (GMD/CEO) of the Company, Mr. Bukola Oluseyi Onajide, by a further term of 3 years, commencing from January 1, 2023, till December 31, 2025.







The humble petition of Hyundai Heavy Industries Fze with its registered office at Dangote Industries Free Zone Development Company, Dangote Industries Free Zone, Lekki Coastal Road Ibeju-Lekki, Lagos, Nigeria, shows as follows:

1. That Hyundai Heavy Industries Fze (hereinafter referred to as "The Enterprise") was registered under the Nigeria Export Processing Zones Authority Act 63 of 1992 (NEPZA) as a Free Zone Enterprise on 16<sup>th</sup> January 2020 with NEPZA FORM RC/1487.
2. That the registered office of the Enterprise is situate at Dangote Industries Free Zone Development Company, Dangote Industries Free Zone, Lekki Coastal Road Ibeju-Lekki, Lagos, Nigeria.
3. That the nominal share capital of the Enterprise is \$100,000 divided into 100,000 ordinary shares of \$1 each.
4. The objects for which the company was established are to engage in installation works at the Lekki Free Zone.
5. That upon registration, the Enterprise was operating maximally with the expected returns on investment and all legal regimes, obligations as well as post incorporation filings of the Enterprise at the Nigeria Export Processing Zones Authority and other government agencies were fully complied with.
6. That the Enterprise has completed its contracts and cannot see viable business opportunity in the future.
7. That at the company's Board of Directors meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> December 2021, it was resolved by the company's Board of Directors that rather than leaving the company in a redundant state, the company be wound up and its assets divested to other areas of business, which the Company Board of Director would later deliberate upon.
8. The Petitioner shall rely on the following Annexures:  
1. Board of Directors Resolution dated 20<sup>th</sup> December 2021.
9. The Petitioner therefore humbly prays for the following orders:  
1. That the affairs of Hyundai Heavy Industries FZE be wound up subject to the supervision of the Court.  
2. That the Court confirm the appointment of Benjamin Ajunwa Esq. of BG Legal as liquidator for the purpose of winding up the affairs of the Enterprise and distributing its assets.  
3. ANY OTHER ORDER as the court may deem just to make in the circumstance.
